

Canterwood HOA Fence Submission Checklist

MyFence.com homeowner prep guide (not an official association form)

Before submitting to the Canterwood Architectural Control Committee:

1. Confirm you are working with the residential HOA ACC, not the golf club.
2. Chain-link is not accepted, including for pet runs - plan cedar or hybrid.
3. Review current Residential Guidelines (ACC documents are updated periodically).
4. Prepare a site plan with lot lines, house, gates, and proposed fence location.
5. Include style drawings, heights, materials, colors, and stain samples.
6. Note golf-course or wooded sightlines that affect placement and height.
7. Request the current ACC application from the Canterwood HOA office / manager.

8. Do not start construction until you have written ACC approval.
9. Keep photos and approval docs for closeout and resale.
